Ken Zimmer - de Beef-a-Thon

Anyone who has been at the JETS for a while knows that the club is a big part of Ken Zimmer's life, and Ken is a big part of the JETS. Ken has put his heart and soul into this great club for longer than most can remember. We love Ken's passion for the club and the sacrifices he has made for it. Ken is a big man....some would say too big. He enjoys a beer and a pie but over the years that enjoyment has caught up with him and he's carrying more weight now than he'd probably like.

Well, the big man has stepped up again and offered to lose weight. But being the clubman that he is, Ken wants to do this as a fundraiser for the JETS. We all know that if Ken is doing something for the club he will give it his very best effort, and I think this is a great initiative from Ken where everybody wins.

Ken's aim is to lose as much weight as possible between now and the end of the home and away season. Like the read-a-thons in Primary school, people can sponsor Ken an amount for each kilo he loses between the first and last official weigh-ins.

For example, if you sponsor Ken \$2 per kilo and he loses 30 kilos, you owe the club \$60.

The first weigh-in will be Saturday 1 April at 7pm at the Lakes, with the last weigh-in on Saturday 12 August giving Ken over four months to lose as much weight as he can.

A competition will be run to see who can guess Ken's weight:- anyone who sponsors Ken for more than 50cents per kilo will automatically be given one guess at his final weight; anyone who sponsors Ken more than \$2 per kilo will automatically be given two guesses at his final weight. A prize will be awarded for the successful guess.

In addition, for \$2 per attempt you can try to guess Ken's weight at three interim weigh-ins in May, June and July for a chance to win a cash prize.

All remaining profits from this fundraiser go to the club.

Folks, this is a great opportunity for Ken and the club, and I strongly encourage you to get involved.
